




TERMS

- 3. ἀγιαζω (hagiazo) to make holy, to sanctify, to set something apart for special use
- 4. ἀγιασμος (hagiasmos) holiness, sanctification





SANCTIFICATION

- 1. God loves sinners just as we are
 - = Justification -> set apart for Himself
- 2. God refuses to leave us just as we are
 - = Sanctification -> set apart for change
 - process of changing us into His image to be useful for His purposes - 12:1-2
- 3. God will complete process 8:28-30
 - = **Glorification** -> set apart for eternity
