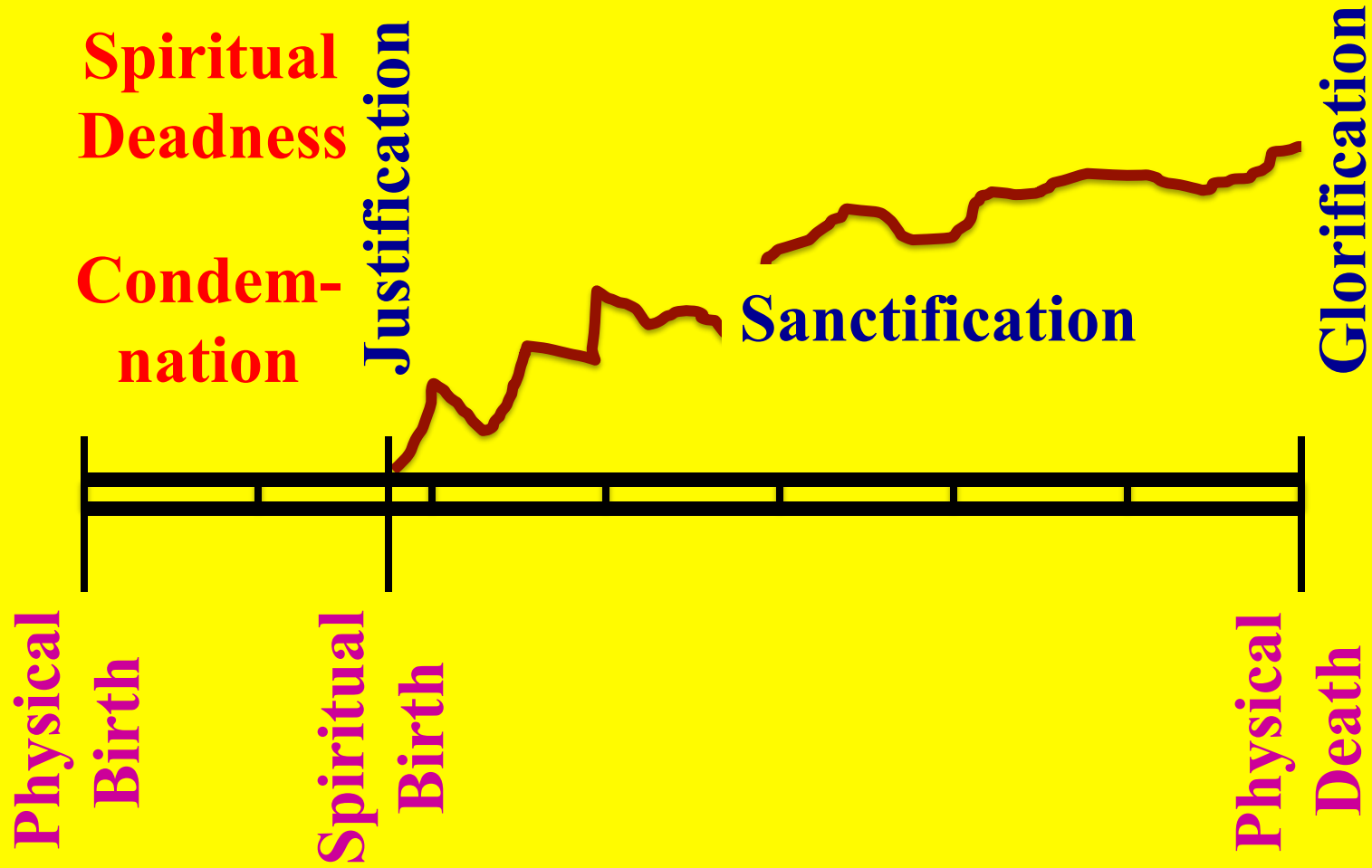
TERMS

1. קדש (qadash) - to set apart
2. ἅγιος (hagios) - something set apart, holy, sacred, holy one = saint
3. ἁγιαζω (hagiazō) - to make holy, to sanctify, to set something apart for special use
4. ἁγιασμος (hagiasmos) - holiness, sanctification

6:1 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in (the) sin so that grace may increase?

CONTINUE IN SIN

1. Continue - **ἐπιμένω (epimeno)**
to remain in a place, persist
2. Sin - **τῆ ἁμαρτία (te hamartia)**
5:20-8:3 - “sin” in singular
with article 25x
-> “the” sin or sin nature from Adam

SIN KILLS



6:1 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in (the) sin so that grace may increase?

6:1-2 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin so that grace may increase? **2** **May it never be!** How shall we who died to sin still live in it?

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CONTINUE IN SIN

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to remain in a place, persist
2. Sin - **τη ἁμαρτία** (te hamartia)
5:20-8:3 - “sin” in singular
with article 25x
-> “the” sin or sin nature from Adam
3. Inconsistent with who we are
4. Contrary to our new nature

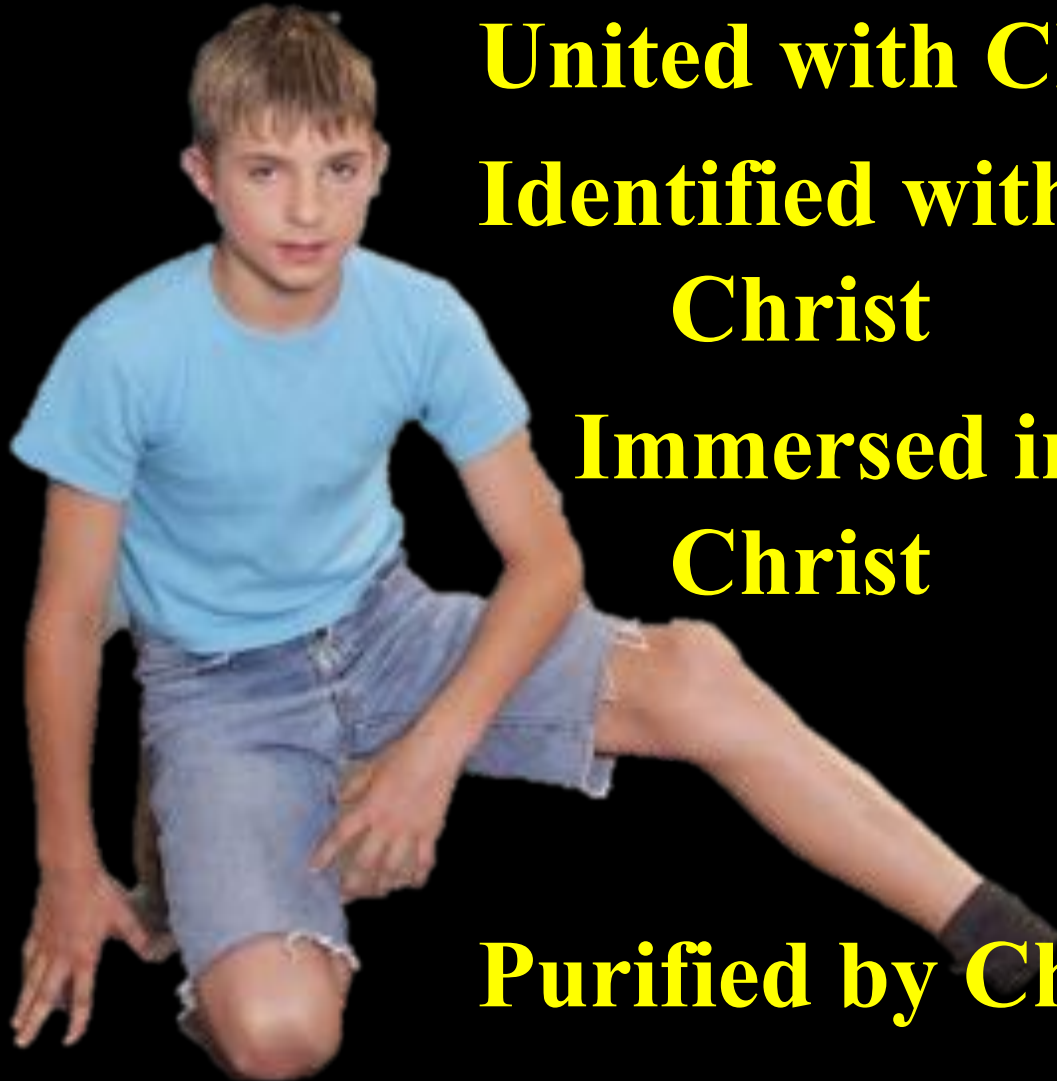
BAPTISM

DEATH

- 1. Physical Death - body separation**
- 2. 2nd Death - eternal separation**
- 3. Comprehensive Spiritual Death -
involves whole person
separation from wholeness
separation from original creation**

- 2. Intellectual (7) - darkened**
- 3. Moral - shame**
- 4. Emotional (10) - fear**
- 5. Social (11-12) - blame**
