





SANCTIFICATION

- 1. God loves sinners just as we are
 - = Justification -> set apart for Himself
- 2. God refuses to leave us just as we are
 - = Sanctification -> set apart for change
 - process of changing us into His image to be useful for His purposes - 12:1-2
- 3. God will complete process 8:19-30
 - = **Glorification** -> set apart for eternity

- Term logic (λογοs), mathematical, accounting
- 2. Illust. Phlm 18, co-signing loan
- 3. To consider, regard, or reason something as true Ac 19:27, 1Cor 13:11, Rom 8:18, Heb 11:19
- 4. To be included or numbered with something Lk 22:37 (Isa 53:12)

<u>λογιζομαι (logizomai)</u>

- Term logic (λογοs), mathematical, accounting
 - in science a reasoned conclusion after all data evaluated
 - $\mathbf{Q} = \mathbf{W} + \mathbf{U}_1 \mathbf{U}_2$
 - **Q** = Heat Absorbed
 - W = Work
 - **U** = **Energy State**

Kelvin-Planck Version:

"It is impossible for any device operating in a cycle to absorb heat from a single reservoir & produce an equivalent amount of work."

Jones & Hawkins




An irreversible tendency to unwind -

"In any physical change that takes place by itself the entropy always increases."



"Thus, heat always flows spontaneously from a hotter to a colder body; gases always seep thru an opening spontaneously from a region of high pressure to a region of low pressure; gases & liquids left by themselves always tend to mix, not unmix. ... Rocks weather & crumble; iron rusts; people grow old. These are all examples of irreversible processes that take place naturally in only one direction &, by their one-sidedness, express the 2nd law of thermodynamics."






