# SALVATION

- Past = JUSTIFICATION  
from PENALTY of Sin
- Future = GLORIFICATION  
from PRESENCE of Sin
- Present = SANCTIFICATION  
from POWER of Sin

# FAITH

1. ΠΙΣΤΕΥΩ (pisteuo) - to believe,  
to have faith
2. Today - tendency to add works to it  
“Salvation is by faith alone but  
saving faith is not alone.”
3. Simple trust that Christ  
accomplished all for salvation
4. Works only for sanctification

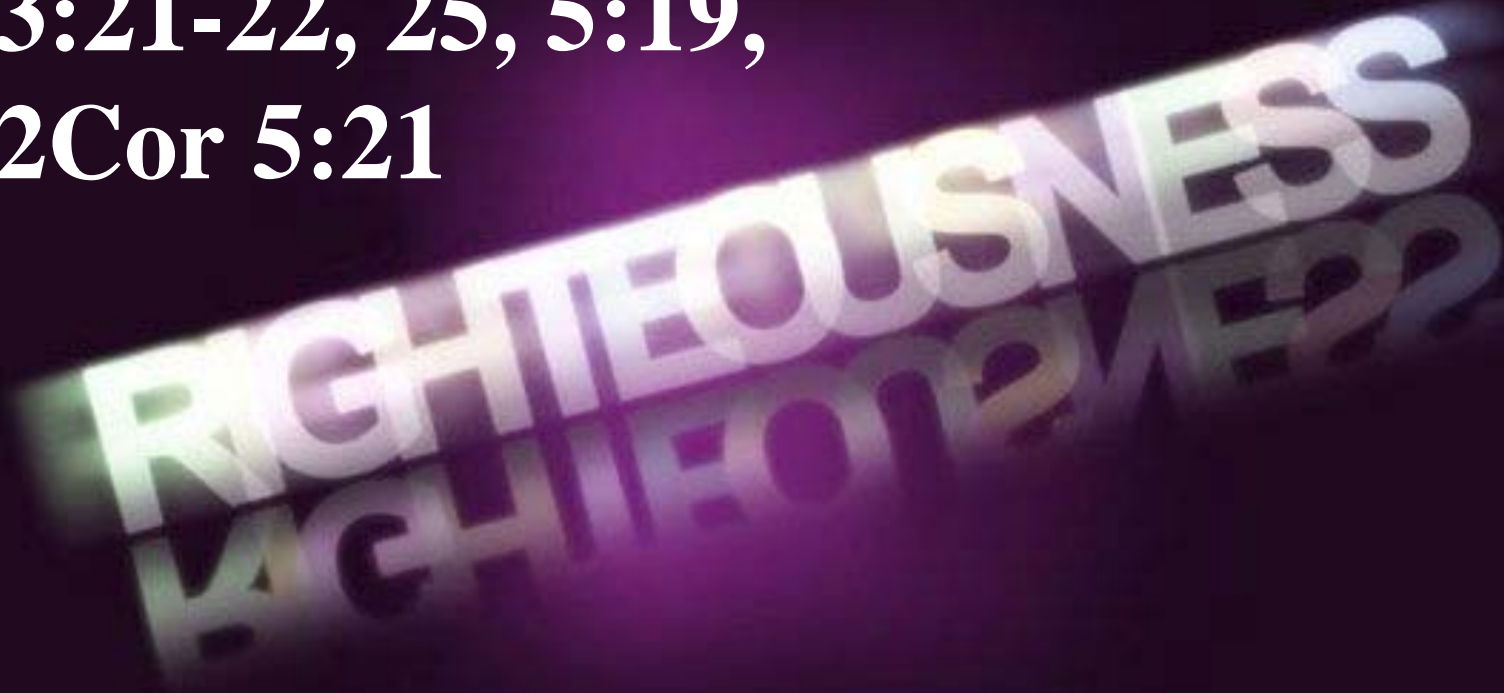
