## Display of Righteousness

3:25-26 whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed; 26 for the demonstration, I say, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

1. Terms -

δικαιος (dikaios) - righteous, just δικαιοσυνη (dikaiosunh) - righteousness

δικαιοω (dikaioo) - to declare righteous, justify

δικαιωσις (dikaiosis) - justification
