TRIBULATION

- 1. Term θλιψις (thlipsis) a pressing, pressure, affliction
- 2. General term for many kinds -Joseph in prison (Ac 7:10), Paul in prison (Phil 1:17), Israel in famine (Ac 7:11), worldly hardships (2Cor 6:4), childbirth (Jn 16:21), marriage (1Cor 7:28), emotional (2Cor 2:4), persecution (2Th 1:4), 7 year Trib.






