5:12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned -

5:12-16 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, ... 15 ... For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many. 16 The gift is not like that which came through the one who sinned; for on the (one) hand the judgment arose from one transgression resulting in condemnation, ...

5:17-19 For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ. 18 So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men. 19 For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, even so through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous.

COMPARISON/CONTRAST

- ➤ 2 men, 2 acts, 2 results, 2 sets of many, 2 federal heads, 2 reigns, 2 eternal effects
- Condemnation/justification, disobedience/obedience, sinful act/act of righteousness, reign of death/reign of grace


