1:1-12 1:1-2 1:1-2 Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who reside as aliens, scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, who are chosen 2 according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, by the sanctifying work of the Spirit, to obey Jesus **Christ and be sprinkled with His** blood: May grace and peace be yours in the fullest measure.

1:6-7 In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been distressed by various trials, 7 so that the proof of your faith, being more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

1:10-11 As to this salvation, the prophets who prophesied of the grace that would come to you made careful searches and inquiries, **11 seeking to know what person or** time the Spirit of Christ within them was indicating as He predicted the sufferings of **Christ and the glories to follow.** 

1:12 It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves, but you, in these things which now have been announced to you through those who preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven -things into which angels long to look.

1:1-12 1:13-4:19 1:13-21 1:13 Therefore, prepare your minds for action, keep sober in spirit, fix your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. 1:14-16 As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance, 15 but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all your behavior; 16 because it is written, "YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY."

**1:17-19** If you address as Father the One who impartially judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves in fear during the time of your stay on earth; 18 knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, 19 but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.

**1:20-21** For He was foreknown before the foundation of the world, but has appeared in these last times for the sake of you 21 who through Him are believers in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.

1:1-12 1:13-4:19 1:13-21 1:22-2:10 1:22-25 1:22-23 Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love one another from the heart, 23 for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, that is, through the living and enduring word of God

1:24-25 For, "ALL FLESH IS LIKE **GRASS, AND ALL ITS GLORY** LIKE THE FLOWER OF **GRASS. THE GRASS** WITHERS, AND THE FLOWER FALLS OFF, 25 BUT **THE WORD OF THE LORD ENDURES FOREVER."** And this is the word which was preached to you.

**2:6** For this is contained in Scripture: "BEHOLD, I LAY IN **ZION A CHOICE STONE, A PRECIOUS CORNER stone,** AND HE WHO BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE **DISAPPOINTED.**"

2:7-8 This precious value, then, is for you who believe; but for those who disbelieve, "THE STONE WHICH THE BUILDERS REJECTED, **THIS BECAME THE VERY CORNER stone**," 8 and, "A STONE **OF STUMBLING AND A ROCK OF OFFENSE"**; for they stumble because they are disobedient to the word, and to this doom they were also appointed.



2:9-10 But you are A CHOSEN RACE, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR God's **OWN POSSESSION, so that you may** proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; 10 for you once were NOT A PEOPLE, but now you are THE **PEOPLE OF GOD; you had NOT RECEIVED MERCY, but now you** have **RECEIVED** MERCY.

3:1-2 In the same way, you wives, be submissive to your own husbands so that even if any of them are disobedient to the word, they may be won without a word by the behavior of their wives, 2 as they observe your chaste and respectful behavior.

**3:7** You husbands in the same way, live with your wives in an understanding way, as with someone weaker, since she is a woman; and show her honor as a fellow heir of the grace of life, so that your prayers will not be hindered.

4:7-9 The end of all things is near; therefore, be of sound judgment and sober spirit for the purpose of prayer. 8 Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins. 9 Be hospitable to one another without complaint.

4:10-11 As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. 11 Whoever speaks, is to do so as one who is speaking the utterances of God; whoever serves is to do so as one who is serving by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

4:12-13 Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal among you, which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange thing were happening to you; 13 but to the degree that you share the sufferings of Christ, keep on rejoicing, so that also at the revelation of His glory you may rejoice with exultation.
