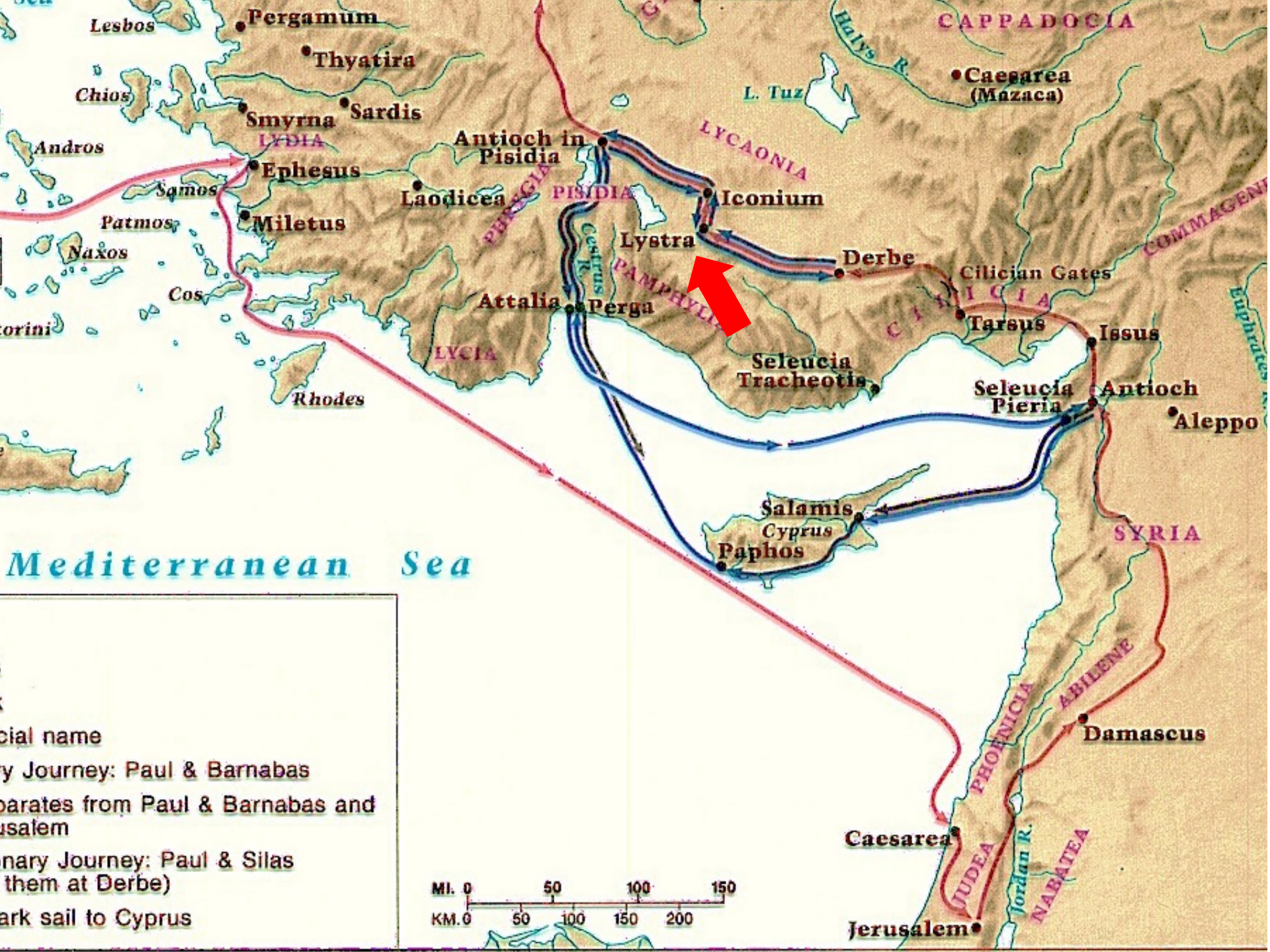

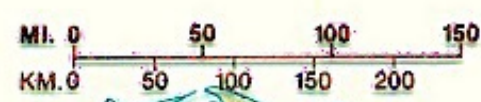

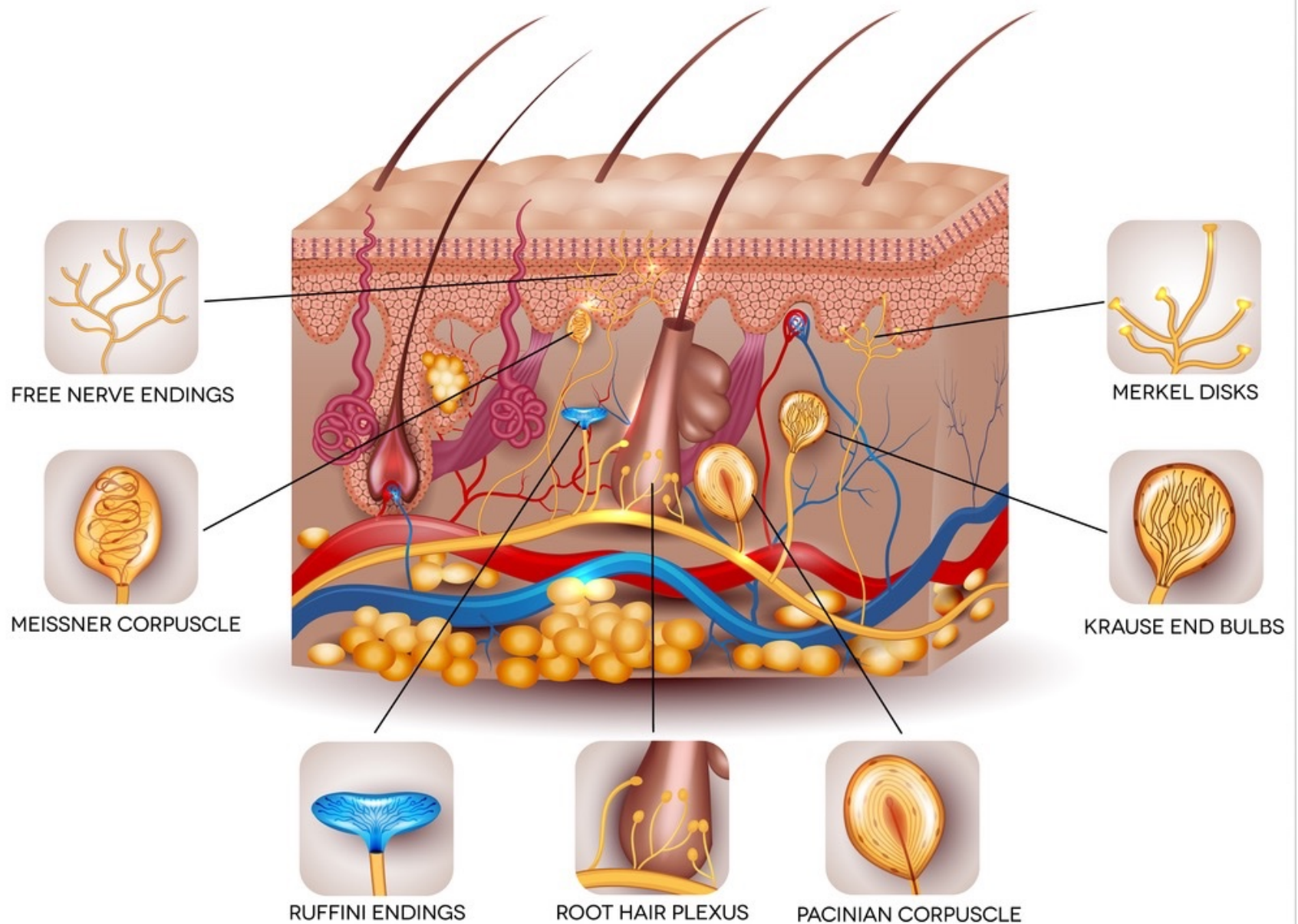

perfect seared



CONDITION
