1:2-6 Abraham was the father of Isaac, **Isaac** the father of Jacob, and **Jacob** the father of Judah and his brothers. **3 Judah** was the father of Perez and Zerah by **Tamar**, **Perez** was the father of Hezron, and **Hezron** the father of Ram. **4 Ram** was the father of Amminadab, **Amminadab** the father of Nahshon, and **Nahshon** the father of Salmon. **5 Salmon** was the father of **Boaz** by **Rahab**, **Boaz** was the father of Obed by **Ruth**, and **Obed** the father of Jesse. **6 Jesse** was the father of David the king. **David** was the father of Solomon by **Bathsheba** who had been the wife of **Uriah**.

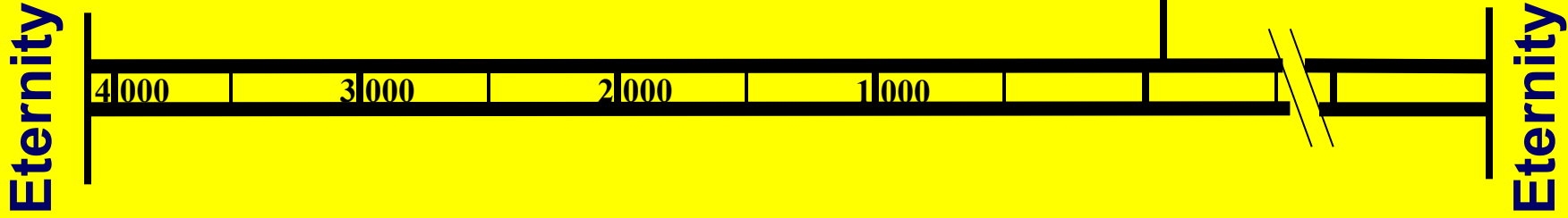

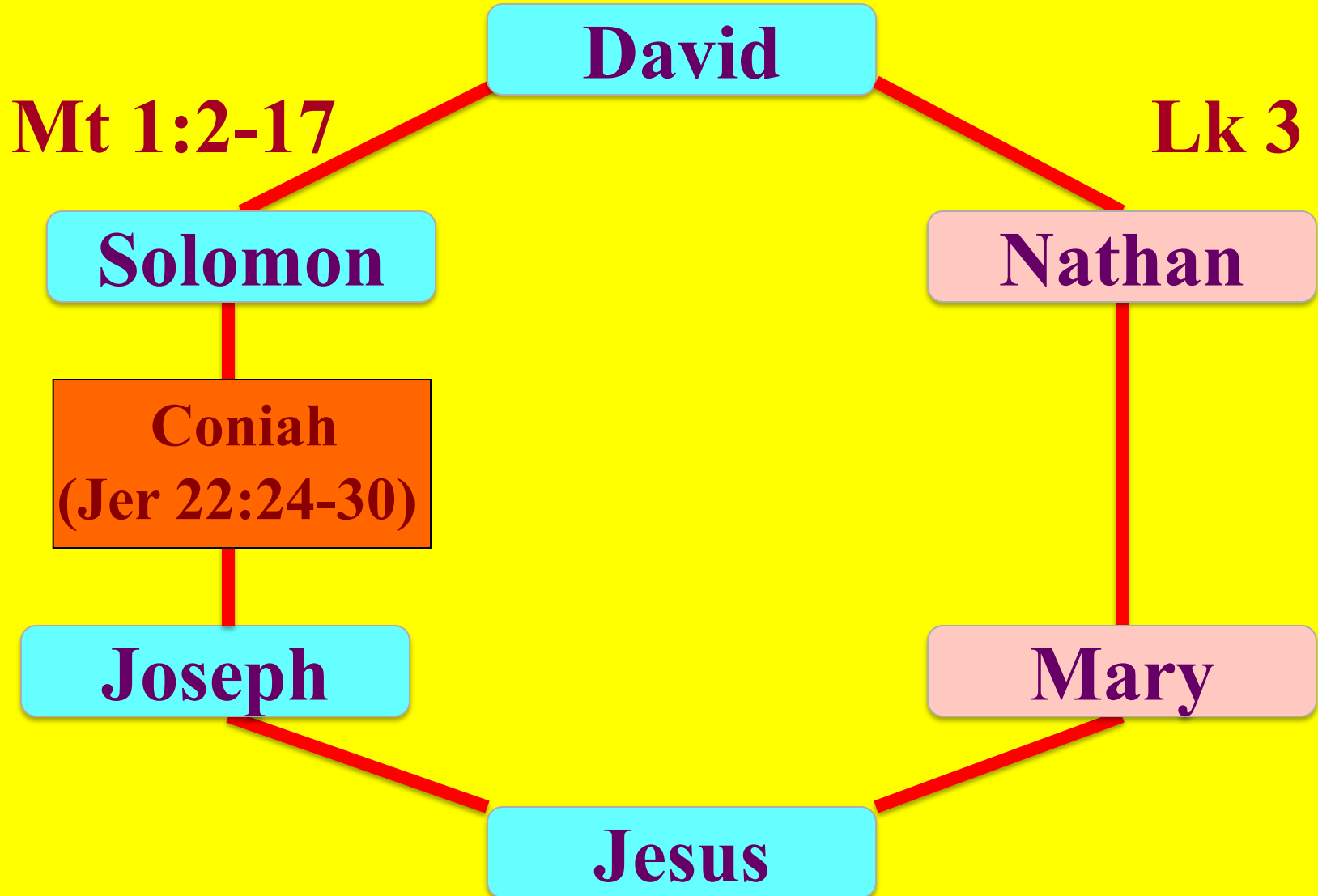

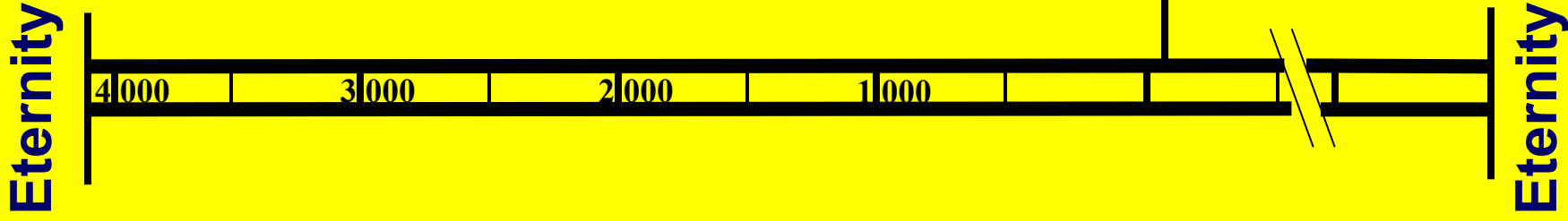
