

Mt 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."




Rom 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?

Heb 2:9 ... Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone.



1Jn 2:2 and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for those of the whole world.
