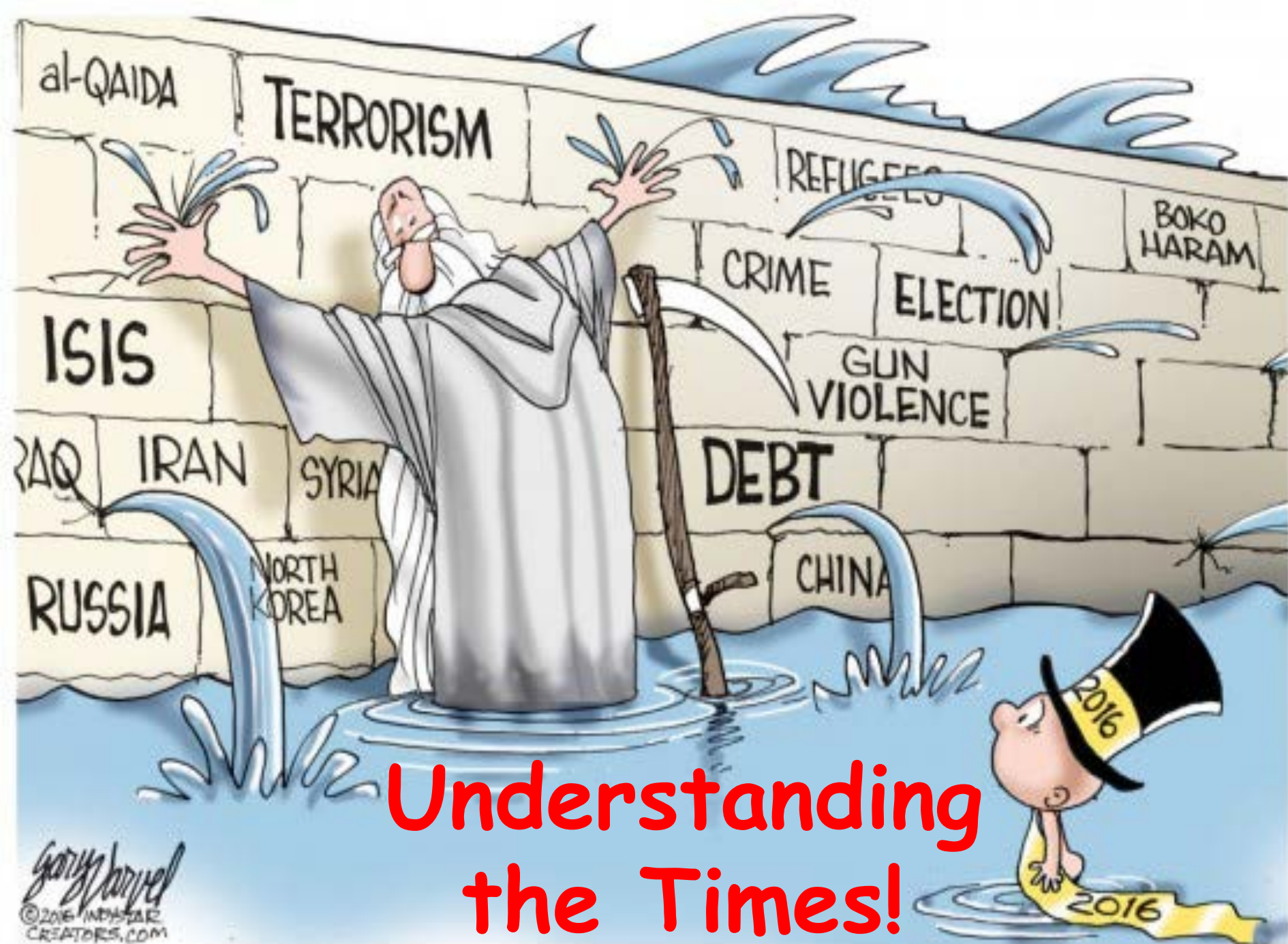

- **Here from severe persecution of Antichrist**
- **Israel - most severe of all
