CONDEMNATION

1. Judgment - κριμα (krima)
2. Condemnation - κατακριμα (katakrima)
A&G - not merely condemnation
but punishment following sentence
3. Usage - 5:16, 18, here
4. For believer - “in Christ”
Eternal punishment put on Christ once
Present punishment of sin nature

8:2 For the law (**νόμος**) of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law (**νόμος**) of sin and of death.

LAW (νομος)

1. Principle of evil in members - 7:21, 23
= sin working in sinful nature
2. Law of God - 7:22
= Mosaic Law or Covenant
3. Different law in members - 7:23 = 7:21
4. Law of mind - 7:23
= God's Word working in new nature



8:2 For the law (νομος) of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law (νομος) of sin and of death.

LAW (νομος)

1. **Law of Spirit of life - 8:2**
= HS working life in new nature
2. **Law of sin & death - 8:2**
= Principle of evil 7:21, 23




BOEING 777
