

Gen 7:19-23 The water prevailed more (כְּאֹר) and more (כְּאֹר) upon the earth, so that all (כל) the high mountains everywhere (לל) under the heavens were covered. 20 ... 21 All (כל) flesh that moved on the earth perished, birds and cattle and beasts and every (לל) swarming thing that swarms upon the earth, and all (خל) mankind; 22 ...

Gen 7:19-23 ... 22 of all (خر) that was on the dry land, all (כל) in whose nostrils was the breath of the spirit of life, died. 23 Thus He blotted out every (خל) living thing that was upon the face of the land, from man to animals to creeping things and to birds of the sky ...; and only (אד) Noah was left, together with those that were with him in the ark.







The Flood split the Continents


Plates spread in months — continental "sprint", not drift




